Dear Brother and Sister Dalton,

We are writing to inform you of the decision of a disciplinary council held in your behalf on November 28th, 1992 and later reconvened for determination of a final decision.

After your refusal to accept an invitation from your family wherein they offered to move you and provide you a home in Portland away from your apostate associations and your refusal of our suggestion for a lesser degree of discipline if you would move and break off association with other apostates and apostate teachings, the unanimous decision of the Disciplinary Council was to excommunicate you from the Lord's Church.

You should be aware that five of the six witness you had testify in your behalf have since changed their position and feel you are involved in apostate practices and recognize excommunication is necessary.

At a future time we hope your hearts will be softened, that you will humble yourselves, sincerely repent and come back to the Lord's true Church.
